
Africa is also the first continent that Islam came to after leaving the Middle East. In 614 A.D. Mohammed advised his followers to escape persecution to Axum in Africa.

Evangelize and disciple all who believe to know and walk in Jesus Christ. (Col. 2:6-7).


Mission Statement


- 6 acre compound near Tamale, Ghana

Medical Outreach



- Alabaster Project is involved in compassionate care ministry through the dental, eye and medical outreach programs.
- We have built an eye clinic complete with a fully equipped surgical unit. We have eye examination surgical unit. We have eye examination equipment (slit lamp, phoropter and auto-refractor), which helps us dispense our large inventory of refurbished eyeglasses.
- Between the two clinics we service about 100 first time patients weekly. This part of the ministry is growing at about 10% annually.
- We have a dental/medical clinic which has been in operation since 2004, over 30,000 patients have been served at this clinic
- The eye clinic has been in operation since 2007.



Eyecare Ministry

Ministry

- Surgeries are regularly performed by visiting ophthalmologists. Thousands of patients have been examined and about Five hundred eye surgical procedures has been performed at the eye clinic.
- We also prescribe reading glasses using an auto refractor connected to a computer to identify the best match from the over 30,000 pairs of refurbished prescription glasses we have in stock.


