
When Jesus lived on earth, the religious leaders were jealous that the people were listening to Him because He spoke with great authority. And so they seized every opportunity they could to trip Him up. In Matthew 22:35–36 we read that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, but then one of the Pharisees, "which was a lawyer, asked him a question, tempting him, saying, Master, which is the great commandment in the law?"

"Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets" (Matthew 22:37–40).

What does it look like to love God so completely, and to love our neighbor as ourselves? The answer is found in the ten commandments God gave to Moses on Mount Sinai in Exodus 20. The first four commandments—no other gods, no idols, not taking God's name in vain, keeping the Lord's Day holy—show us how to acknowledge God's holiness and sovereignty in our lives.

The last six commandments—honor your parents, do not kill, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not lie, do not covet—show us how to treat others as we would like them to treat us, as Jesus taught in Luke 6:31 and Matthew 7:12. It's impossible to love God and others of course, without the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives. Acts of love are borne out of hearts of love, and "This commandment have we from him, That he who loveth God love his brother also" (1 John 4:21).
