Every year, math enthusiasts celebrate Pi Day on March 14, because the date spells the first three digits (3.14) of pi, or π , the ratio of a circle's circumference to its diameter. It can't be expressed as a fraction, and its decimal representation never ends. Yet people around the world have been known to memorize pi thousands of digits beyond the decimal point, and people today celebrate Pi Day by eating pizza and dessert pies.


