Physical And Spiritual Eyes Are Opened!

"I can see again," exclaimed a patient who had been blind for fifteen years! Thank you Lord for the gift of eye surgery! Every good and perfect gift comes from above. This month we hosted a medical team from Mexico. We will long remember this medical outreach. From the very beginning, we all could sense the presence of the Lord and we had great anticipation for what the Lord was going to accomplish in our midst. As usual the Lord exceeded our expectations!

Well over a thousand patients were examined, many were blind from mature cataracts in both eyes. The incidence of glaucoma is very high in Sub-Saharan Africa, and even though we could have done surgery on almost all the patients, glaucoma would have prevented them from gaining their sight back. In five days we operated on 97 blind, and near-to-blind patients. Thanks to Jesus Christ all the surgeries




were successful. Many of the blind received their sight back! What a glorious time we had rejoicing with those whom God smiled upon and their sight was restored. The message of salvation went forth with power! No one could resist the Holy Spirit. The team consisted of eight medical professionals and one ophthalmologist! Dr. Antonio, who paid for his family and his entire staff to come to Ghana and serve those in need. God honored his sacrifice and poured out His Spirit abundantly. Many received their physical sight as well as their spiritual ones! We give thanks to God for all of you who continue stand with us in prayer. May the Lord remember you also for good.
